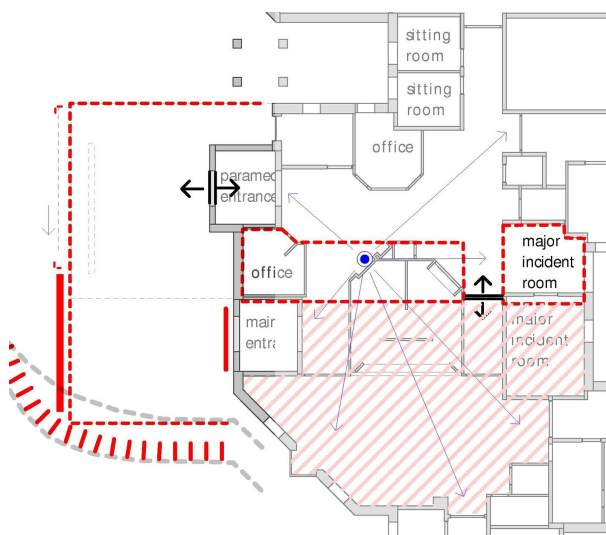

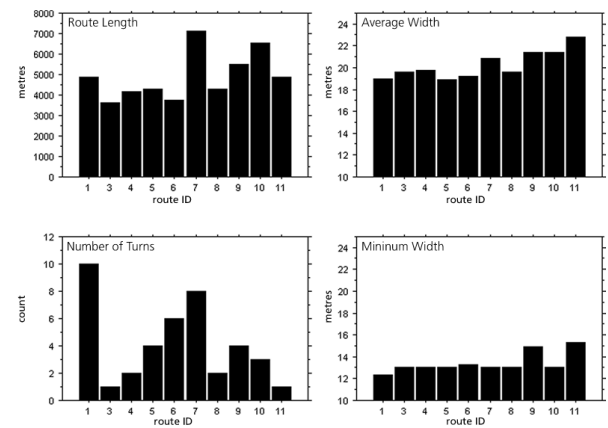


Design guidance to reduce crime risk in Accident and Emergency Departments
