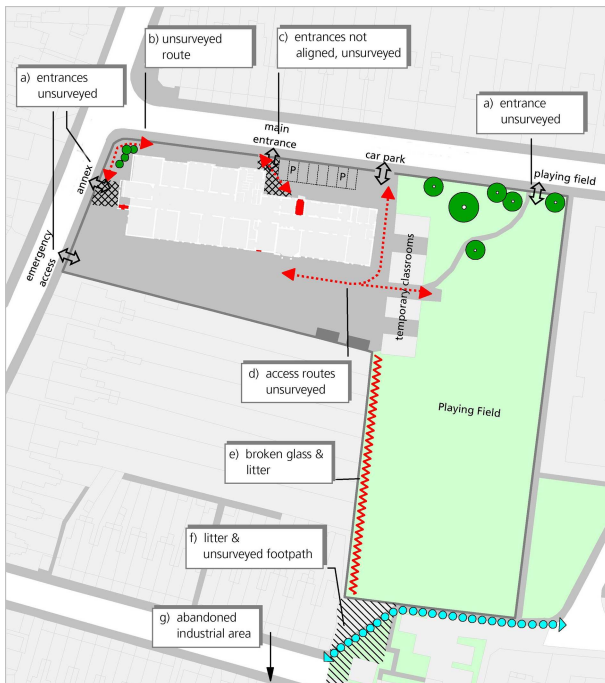


Scoping Study

An audit of the potential of a site for active public space and pedestrian movement

A scoping study provides a fast initial assessment of the key pedestrian issues relating to a specific site, with the support of relevant comparison data and our experience gained from previous studies. Following the site visit, a short report or presentation can be produced.

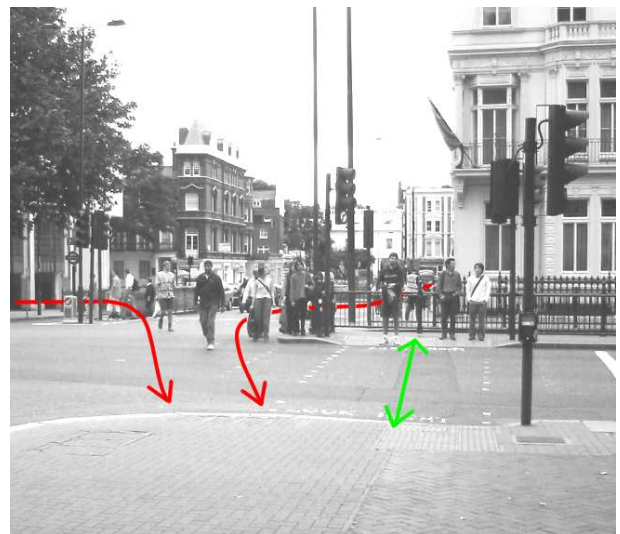


Public space audit identifies key opportunities and constraints of a site

Benefits of Scoping Studies:

- Provision of feedback at a very early stage to help steer design strategies.
- Identification of key issues relating to pedestrian movement (for example, potential new links for increased flows, potential points of conflict with vehicles etc.)
- Professional opinion on the key Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats relating to pedestrian use of the development.
- Highlighting of relevant comparative examples from best practice and previous research.
- Detailed suggestions for analysis strategy appropriate to meet the client objectives.
- Illustration of issues with photographs, maps, figures and a summary report or presentation.

Scoping Studies have been used to inform projects of all kinds, from large urban development masterplans to small local government transport plans.
